God which is at Corinth," although the scholarly consensus holds
Sosthenes was the assistant who wrote down the text of the letter
at Paul's direction.

Called "a masterpiece of pastoral theology", it addresses various
issues that had arisen in the Christian community at Corinth.

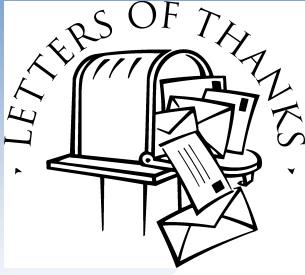
Central Christian will be sending out text messages and phone calls to remind members of upcoming meetings and inform every one of prayer needs.
